外国人留学生獲得への取り組み①

外国人学生増の背景

Waseda Vision 150(創立150周年(2032年)に向けた本学のロードマップ、2012年に策定)にて「外国人学生1万人」を標榜



- ・海外協定校の増強(交換留学の活性化)
- ・短期留学(受け入れプログラム)の開発
- ・クォーター制の導入
- ・英語による学位プログラムの開発
- ・日本語教育プログラムの拡充
- ・外国人学生が受験しやすい入試制度への改定・実施



外国人留学生獲得への取り組み②

外国人学生が出願しやすい制度への改定・実施

- ・渡日を要さない入学試験の拡充(一つの解)

⇒書類選考が主な判定手段

⇒提出書類からの出願資格判断、学力判定の難しさ



出願資格判定における課題

12年目の課程を修了しているのか

- ・12年教育と11年教育が混在している国・地域(マレーシアなど)
⇒教育制度が変わることも多く、追い切れていないのが現状
- ・高校(12年課程)を卒業しているが、12年目の成績が出ないケース(中国で増加中)
⇒高校2年間で3年分の課程を修了、最終学年は日本語学校等で学習というケース(成績証明書からは読み取れない)
- ・各国の教育制度で認められた学校なのか
例:北米などに多く見られるホームスクーリング(最近では南アジアからの問い合わせも増加中)
⇒初見の学校に関しては調査に相当の時間を要する



合否判定における課題

世界各国の大学入学資格試験に対応する難しさ

- ・原則志願者が受けた教育制度による試験の提出を求めているが、現状としては提出可能な試験が限られている
⇒学部が判定資料として採用するための根拠を収集することが困難なこともある
- ・リストに入っていない国に関してはSATやACTを提出させている。
⇒英語学位プログラムであれば問題ないが、日本語による通常の課程志望者にとって最適であるか
- ・提出を認めた試験制度についても変更がある
⇒志願者からの問い合わせで発覚するケースもある



結論

- ・12年目の正規課程を修了したことがわかるデータの集積
- ・各国の大学入学資格試験の詳細(カリキュラムなど)や得点によるレベル判定が可能なデータの集積



一大学だけでの努力では限界がある。各大学等が集積した情報を共有できる仕組み、もしくは調査を依頼できる機関が必要
