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




Information model for observing university conditions






Internal and external expectations for JPCUP

- In 2010, the higher education database services (university information provision services) were terminated after the government's budget screening process.
 - National Center for University Entrance Examinations/University Information Provision Service (Heart System, etc.)
 - Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO)/University Information Provision Service (Student Support Information Database, etc.) as part of the student support programs
 - National Institution for Academic Degrees and University Evaluation (NIAD-UE, the predecessor of NIAD-QE)/University information provision service (University Information Database, etc.) as part of the duty of information collection, organization, and provision
 - Center for National University Finance and Management (CUFM)/University information provision service (National University Corporation Management Handbook, etc.) as part of the duty of information provision for supporting improvement of finance and management
- In April 2011, the information on education and research activities to be provided has been specified, as stipulated in Paragraph 1 of Article 172-2, the Regulation for Enforcement of the School Education Act.
- "Interim Report on the Utilization and Public Provision of Education Information at Universities" (August 2011), Expert meeting for supporting the utilization and promoting the public provision of education information at universities, MEXT
 - Each university should voluntarily and autonomously engage in the use and public provision of education information.
 - In this regard, it is important for university associations and other relevant organizations to support and complement the efforts of each university.
 - Furthermore, through voluntary cooperation among university associations and other relevant organizations, the development of a common infrastructure for the use and public provision of education information should be promoted.
- Three Objectives of the JPCUP
 - To clearly illustrate the mission of each university and the condition of its education and research activities and to promote the analysis of education information that will contribute to enhancing the quality of education.
 - To provide information in an accessible manner to stakeholders and interested parties in university education, both domestically and internationally, including prospective students, local authorities, and industry representatives.
 - To help universities and colleges respond to various surveys.




The decision-making organization of JPCUP




Public provision of education information through JPCUP




Public provision of education information for students planning to study in Japan

 - Personnel of the management strategy office, institutional research (IR) office, information infrastructure department, and other departments who handle university data
 - Researchers working with higher education data
 - Service innovation and delivery strategies pertaining to higher education data
 - Meaningful collaboration with public and private entities that operate higher education data management
 - NIAD-QE, The Promotion and Mutual Aid Corporation for Private Schools in Japan
 - National Institute for Educational Policy Research (NIER), National Institute of Science and Technology Policy (NISTEP)
