

Decision of Institutional Thematic Assessment

The attainment level of the goals of the National Institute of Technology, Kitakyushu College is satisfactory in the area of Institutional Thematic Assessment, Theme A: Research Activities.

The review committee has identified the following areas for improvement in Institutional Thematic Assessment A:

- 1) The College's system for monitoring the implementation status and problems of its research activities and making improvements is insufficient (Viewpoint A-1-(4)).

The attainment level of the goals of the National Institute of Technology, Kitakyushu College is good in the area of Institutional Thematic Assessment, Theme B: Community Outreach.

The review committee has identified the following best practices in the area of Institutional Thematic Assessment B:

- 1) The College actively contributes to the community with a range of well-received activities, such as open courses, on-site lectures, science support projects for elementary and junior high school students to perform science experiments and robot operations and demonstrations, technical exchanges with local industries and municipalities, and technical exchange meetings and other events under the Technology Consortium of NIT, Kitakyushu College.

The review committee has identified the following areas for improvement in Institutional Thematic Assessment B:

- 1) The College's system for monitoring the implementation status and problems of its community outreach and making improvements is insufficient (Viewpoint B-1-(4)).
