Decision of Institutional Thematic Assessment

The attainment level of the goals of the National Institute of Technology, Kurume College is good in the area of Institutional Thematic Assessment, Theme B: Community Outreach.

The review committee has identified the following best practices in the area of Institutional Thematic Assessment B:

1) The Industry-Academia-Private Collaboration Techno Center has held 41 children's workshops for elementary and junior high school students and 15 public lectures for working adults in the five years from 2015 to 2019, and the degree of satisfaction is over 90 percent. The College also opened the "Junior Doctor Training School in KOSEN," a project designed to discover and develop human resources leading the next generation of science and technology, which was adopted for the "Fostering next-generation Scientists Program." The project has produced successful outcomes that include the participating students receiving presentation awards at Science Conference 2019 hosted by the Japan Science and Technology Agency.

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
