The review committee has identified the following best practices in the area of Institutional Thematic Assessment B:

- 1) The College has made efforts to promote human resource development in the region by providing disaster prevention delivery lessons, open lectures for residents, offshore training for companies, transfer of knowledge about the ocean, and contribution to the community utilizing ships. In particular, disaster prevention delivery lessons for elementary and junior high school students in Yamaguchi Prefecture have been held since 2008, and community contribution activities have been actively carried out.
