

Decision of Institutional Thematic Assessment

The attainment level of the goals of National Institute of Technology, Kagawa College, is good in the area of Institutional Thematic Assessment A (research activities) set by NIAD-QE.

Good practices in Institutional Thematic Assessment A identified by the review committee include:

- Basically maintaining a high level of external funding in terms of the number and amount of funds acquired, resulted from supporting research activities of this college's academic staff and acquisition of external funds by assigning two University-Industry cooperation coordinators, and having established a structure to provide latest information at any time, along with holding a workshop and explanatory meeting for Grants-in-Aid for Scientific Research.

The attainment level of the goals of National Institute of Technology, Kagawa College, is good in the area of Institutional Thematic Assessment B (educational services offered to students other than full-time students) set by NIAD-QE.

Good practices in the area of Institutional Thematic Assessment B identified by the review committee include:

- Establishing the Human Resources Development Office to launch the Collaborative Education Center of Emerging Technology and the Research and Development Center for Regional Innovation, in order to contribute to regional education and culture development, and actively conducting open classes targeting the general public, educational activities in science and engineering fields for local elementary and junior high school students, community engagement through support for off-campus and special events (lectures on technology, and regional cooperation projects) that are producing good results, judging from the number of service recipients and their satisfaction rating.

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
