

Decision of Institutional Thematic Assessment

The attainment level of the goals of National Institute of Technology, Toyama College, is good in the area of Institutional Thematic Assessment A (research activities) set by NIAD-QE.

Good practices in Institutional Thematic Assessment A identified by the review committee include:

- Increase in the number of external funds acquired every year through Grants-in-Aid for Scientific Research, resulting from efforts to improve application details through mutual check of the application by organizing an academic staff study group, in addition to conducting a seminar for acquisition of external funds through Grants-in-Aid for Scientific Researcher under the leadership of the principal, etc.

The attainment level of the goals of National Institute of Technology, Toyama College, is good in the area of Institutional Thematic Assessment B (educational services offered to students other than full-time students) set by NIAD-QE.

Good practices in the area of Institutional Thematic Assessment B identified by the review committee include:

- Preparation of 23 seminar plans at the request of companies in FY2016, with expansion efforts, that resulted from favorable reviews from companies for 4 corporate education/businessmen seminars conducted in FY2015 as part of the business of the Solution Center for Product Development established in the Head Office of Product Development and Community Outreach.

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
