

Decision of Institutional Thematic Assessment

The attainment level of goals of Yuge National College of Maritime Technology is good in the area of Institutional Thematic Assessment A (research activities) set by NIAD-UE.

Good practices identified in Institutional Thematic Assessment A include:

- The development of tablet-type communication terminals (Shima-Tab) to watch over the elderly, construction of the Web Meeting System (internet TV conference system) connecting remote islands to prevent the degradation of administrative services in Kamijima Town (mainly comprised of four remote islands), development of the Hull Block Most Suitable Placement Supporting System to find the optimum ship block layout for the effective use of limited dockyard space, experiment and evaluation of the Floating-type Tide Generation System as joint research with Kamijima Town, and other unique ICT initiatives based in the local community.

The attainment level of goals of Yuge National College of Maritime Technology is good in the area of Institutional Thematic Assessment B (educational services offered to students other than full-time students) set by NIAD-UE.

Good practices identified in Institutional Thematic Assessment B include:

- Unique initiatives that take advantage of the college's resources, offering the 1 day Captain (Daily Captain) experience aboard the training ship "YUGE-MARU" (T.S. Yuge-maru) and other educational services, which have proved to be effective, and providing maritime themes and using the Yuge-Marun in the Science Partnership Project (SPP).

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
