

Decision of Institutional Thematic Assessment

The attainment level of goals of the National Institute of Technology, Hakodate College, is generally good in the area of Institutional Thematic Assessment A (research activities) set by the National Institution for Academic Degrees and University Evaluation.

The attainment level of goals of the National Institute of Technology, Hakodate College, is excellent in the area of Institutional Thematic Assessment B (educational services offered to students other than full-time students) set by the National Institution for Academic Degrees and University Evaluation.

Good practices identified in Institutional Thematic Assessment B include:

- The “Performance-based easy-to-understand science lecture” program combining scientific experiments and theater, selected in FY2012 for the Japan Science and Technology Agency’s “Program for promoting science communication: supporting institutional science communication activities .” This unique initiative is designed as a fun and easy-to-understand lecture based on the participants’ comments that science lectures are enjoyable but hard to understand. The lecture is given each year at the Hakodate International Science Festival, held as part of the activities of Science Support Hakodate (a network of education institutions in the Hakodate region) and Campus Consortium Hakodate (a consortium of universities, colleges of technology, and junior colleges).

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
