

## **Decision of Institutional Thematic Assessment**

The attainment level of the goals of Aichi University of Education is good in the area of Institutional Thematic Assessment B, Community Outreach.

Good practices identified in Institutional Thematic Assessment B include:

- The establishment of the Center for Community-Based Education and Cooperation, the Center for Clinical Practice in Education, the Center for Promotion of Science and Technology Education, *etc.* under the auspices of the Organization for Creation and Development of Education, which jointly provide for community outreach activities in accordance with the University's strengths;
- Providing open lectures for incumbent teachers, including those certified according to the Teacher's Certificate Act as well as public lectures for citizenship, together with other diverse public programs, including university lectures partnering with Nagoya City, open lectures partnering with nearby cities, and open lectures co-hosted with nearby cities;
- The continued initiatives that encourage undergraduate and postgraduate students to participate in the supporting activities for Japanese language education for non-Japanese elementary and junior high school students in four nearby cities; and
- On-site Science Labs and Classes for Making Things by Hand, which, planned and organized mainly by the students target nearby elementary and secondary school students and local residents.

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
