

## **Decision of Institutional Thematic Assessment**

The attainment level of the goals of Kyoto Institute of Technology is good in the area of Institutional Thematic Assessment B, Community Outreach.

Good practices identified in Institutional Thematic Assessment B include:

- The “Kyoto Industry, Culture and Art Center and K16 Project,” a joint application with Maizuru College, the National Institute of Technology, which, selected in FY2013 for MEXT’s Program for Promoting Universities as the Center of Community, promotes comprehensive community outreach initiatives focused on the Center for Community Promotion.

The attainment level of the goals of Kyoto Institute of Technology is generally good in the area of Institutional Thematic Assessment C, Internationalization of Higher Education.

Good practices and accomplishments identified in Institutional Thematic Assessment C include:

- OPEN-TECH INNOVATION: An Initiative for Global, Social, and Regional Collaboration, which, selected for the FY2014 Top Global University Project funded by MEXT, aims to become a local force to drive and steer globalization.

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
