

Decision of Institutional Thematic Assessment

The attainment level of the goals of Kyushu Institute of Technology is good in the area of Institutional Thematic Assessment C, Internationalization of Higher Education.

The Institute is above standard in terms of “development of an international teaching and learning environment,” and above standard in terms of “admission of international students.”

Good practices identified in Institutional Thematic Assessment C include:

- The establishment of the Malaysia Super Satellite Campus (MSSC), an overseas education and research center in Universiti Putra Malaysia in April 2013, which has enhanced exchange activities with Universiti Putra Malaysia in education and research, as well as the institutional international exchange programs related to MSSC to promote the internationalization of education;
- The preparation of annual achievement reports on the exchange activities with partner schools abroad, whose suggestions help prioritize institutions to partner with and fund international projects appropriately in accordance with their track records; and
- The Graduate School of Engineering’s Space Engineering International Course, which allows students to acquire an academic degree (master’s or doctoral degree) solely in English only from FY2013, with government-sponsored foreign students admitted through coordination with the United Nations Office for Outer Space Affairs, Austria.

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
